Who: K-5 students in Texas

What: Students submit a unique piece of artwork portraying positive ways to Take Care of Texas. The artwork must be two-dimensional and submitted on an 8.5"x11" piece of paper (landscape format is recommended). It must include the slogan "Take Care of Texas. It's the only one we've got."

When: Contest opens on Jan. 3 and closes on March 1, 2020. Winners will be announced on April 15, 2020.

**How:** Participants submit their artwork to the TCEQ and each of the TCEQ's regional offices will select a winner. See the map for locations. Of those 16 winners, one will be selected as the grand-prize winner. Visit <TakeCareOfTexas. org/art-contest> for mailing instructions.

**Why:** Students have the opportunity to learn about ways to protect the environment and share their knowledge with others.
