## **Take Care of Texas Video Contest Checklist**

Each video **must portray positive ways** Texans can protect the environment, including **keeping the air clean**, **keeping the water clean**, **conserving water**, **conserving energy**, and **reducing waste**. We encourage students to explore **one** of these topics.

$\Box$ The video must contain the <b>slogan</b> "Take Care of Texas. It's the only one we've got." expressed verbally or by using the Take Care of Texas logo.
☐ <b>TakeCareOfTexas.org</b> is <b>THE ONLY allowable reference</b> for statistical information, facts, and data.
$\square$ <b>Videos may not have been previously</b> submitted, distributed, or aired or have won any other award in any other competition.
$\square$ Video must be <b>30 seconds</b> long, give or take one second.
$\square$ The ideal video quality resolution is <b>1920</b> x <b>1080p</b> .
$\Box$ The maximum file size is 64 MB.
$\square$ Videos must feature <b>horizontal</b> (wide) orientation, like a movie screen.
$\square$ Videos must be <b>original work</b> created by the student.
<ul> <li>□ Record any <b>sources of</b> unoriginal material, such as music, sounds, videos, photos, graphics, or other video in the <b>Take Care of Texas Video Contest Reference Sheet</b></li> <li>□ All visual and audio content must be original and royalty free (<b>not copyrighted</b>), or written permission from the copyright holder granting use of the copyrighted material.</li> </ul>
$\square$ Video message should be <b>positive</b> : not rude, violent, bossy, or otherwise negative.
$\square$ Video <b>should not contain any</b> company logos, product brands, or store names.

## **Submitting Your Video**

Upload your entry **before 5:00 p.m. on the contest deadline** with the required documents.

- Video file name should include the student's first and last name.
- o Take Care of Texas Video Contest Reference Sheet for any **sources of** unoriginal material, such as music, sounds, videos, photos, or graphics.

## Late entries will not be accepted.
