## **Take Care of Texas Video Contest Checklist**

Each video must portray positive ways Texans can protect the environment, including **keeping the air clean**, **keeping the water clean**, **conserving water**, **conserving energy**, and **reducing waste**. It is important that the video portrays a **positive message**. We encourage students to explore **one** of these topics.

□ The video must contain the **slogan "Take Care of Texas. It's the only one we've got.**" expressed verbally or by using the Take Care of Texas logo.

□ **TakeCareOfTexas.org is the only allowable reference** for statistical information, facts, and data. Videos that express such information from other sources, no matter how reliable, will be disqualified.

□ **Videos may not have been previously** submitted, distributed, or aired or have won any other award in any other competition.

□ Video must be **30 seconds** long, give or take one second.

□ Resolution: the ideal video quality is **1920 x 1080p**.

□ Videos must feature **horizontal** (wide) orientation, like a movie screen. **Vertical** (tall) videos will be disqualified.

□ Videos must be **original work** created by the student.

□ All visual and audio content must be original and royalty free (**not copyrighted**), or the student must submit written permission from the copyright holder granting use of the copyrighted material.

□ Videos composed of **original material** will score higher than videos composed of stock images and sounds.

□ Video message should be **positive**: not rude, violent, bossy, or otherwise negative.

□ Video **should not contain any** company logos, product brands, or store names. When in doubt, blur it out.

□ Record in a text, **sp**readsheet, or PDF the following information for any **sources** of unoriginal material, such as music, sounds, videos, photos, graphics, or other video:

- Name of con<mark>ten</mark>t source: artist, website, etc.
- Title of work
- Type of wor<mark>k (</mark>video clip, sound effect, song, graphic, etc.)
- URL where this element can be found and confirmed

## **Submitting Your Video**

Upload your entry **before 5:00 p.m. CST Friday**, Dec. 2, 2022, with the required documents.

## Late entries will not be accepted.

- $\circ$  Video file name should include the student's first and last name.
- Th<mark>e maximum file size is 100 MB.</mark>
- A list of all material that is not the student's original creation: stock images, sound effects, and music. TCEQ staff will check that these sources.
