Household Hazardous Waste Symbols

Instructions: Match the symbol with the function.



Signals that materials can detonate, deflagrate, or react violently.

Alert users to the presence of materials that can easily ignite.



Serves as an indicator for chemicals that can release oxygen or other oxidizing substances.

Signifies that the product has potential to cause burns or harm to skin, eyes, throat, or stomach is touched or swallowed.



Warns that a substance can cause severe, immediate, or fatal health effects after a single or short-term exposure.

Alerts users that a chemical poses acute or long-term risks to aquatic ecosystems, including toxicity to fish, algae, and organisms.



Used to indicate that a chemical is hazardous to the ozone layer and poses less serious health effects.

Alerts users to substances that cause chronic, long-term, or severe health damage.



Warns that contents are stored under high pressure, posing risks of explosion if heated, punctured, or damaged.
